CCA Award Application

The CCA Award is a \$1000 scholarship available for a graduating student of the SCCHS Choral Program who is furthering their education at a post-secondary institution. The recipient must be enrolled in at least one music class in their first year. Those pursuing a career in music education or music performance will be given priority. If no one is entering a vocal or music education program, the decision is based on their current and future involvement in choral/vocal music. To apply for this award students must submit the application form, current transcripts and a written response to provided questions.

Application Process

- 1. Fill in the school form
- 2. Attach a copy of your current transcripts
- 3. Answer the following questions:
 - 1. What has your involvement been in the music program through your high school years? (all ensembles, grade/years, etc)
 - 2. More specifically, what has your involvement been in the choral program?
 - 3. Why is choir important? Why is music and/or music education important?
 - 4. What have you learned from being involved in the music department?
 - 5. What are your plans for next year? What are you studying? Where are you studying?
 - 6. Are you taking any music courses next year? Will you be involved in any musical ensembles? Explain.
 - 7. How will you be involved in music in the future? (beyond post secondary studies)
 - 8. Why do you feel you are the best candidate for this award?
- 4. Submit your application to Student Services by the appointed date.
- 5. The successful applicant will be notified at the SCCHS Awards Night.
- 6. Award recipient may choose to defer this award for one year, with written notice of intention to take a 'gap year' before entering post secondary studies.
- 7. A cheque will be issued in the fall and mailed upon receiving proof of enrollment from the successful applicant.
