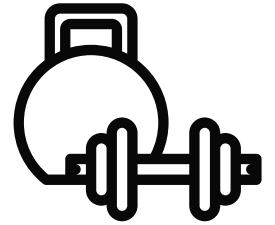
TOONIES FOR TERRY
