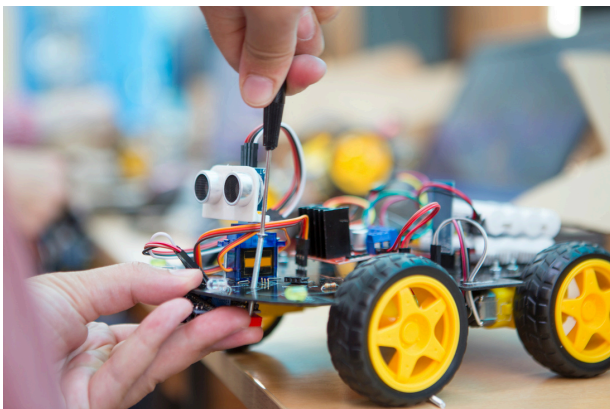

Student Transcripts – New process called MyCreds!

Do you need a copy of your student transcript to apply for university or college, or to apply for scholarships? Please read the following to understand the new process.

The Ministry of Education has upgraded the high school and Adult 12 transcript process. Learners will now use the MyCreds or MesCerti (French transcript) portal to view and share their official Transcript of Secondary Level Achievement. The digital transcript is secure, efficient and convenient. MyCreds is a national initiative led by the Association of Registrars of the Universities and Colleges of Canada.

MyCreds FAQ:

When can I access or learn about this new process?

Your career counselor will be supporting Grade 12 students in semester 1 within group sessions and grade 11 students in semester 2. However, students can individually login at any time and create their account to be able to access or forward their transcripts.

What will I need to create a MyCreds account?

You will need a personal email address that you currently use and will continue to use after high school, as well as a government issued photo ID to confirm your identity. The photo ID could be a driver's license, a non-driver photo ID, a passport, etc. Knowing your Saskatchewan Learning ID is also helpful (this can be found in MSS).

What if I don't have a government issued photo ID?

You can get a non-driver photo ID [from SGI](#). The first one is free.

What options could I use for payment?

You can purchase a share credit in MyCreds using a credit or debit card that has the three or four digit CVV code on the back. The card does not have to be in your name, but the address information on the payment page must match the billing address. [See how to purchase share credits.](#)

I have ordered my high school or Adult 12 transcripts prior to August 1, do I have to re-order?

No, you will not have to re-order. All current transcripts orders will be fulfilled using the current technology. A personal email address is required for access to the MyCreds Learner Portal and to view and share their transcripts.

I graduated years ago. Do I use MyCreds to gain access to my transcripts?

Yes. Follow the previous instructions to access your transcripts as well.

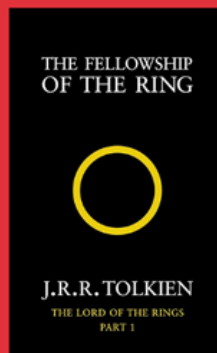

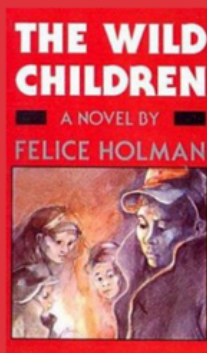

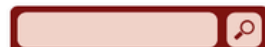

CTRL + F



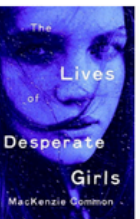
SEARCH SHORTCUT

If you are in a document or in a web browser, press Ctrl + the F key on the keyboard to bring up a search box in the top right corner of the screen.

You can then type in a keyword or phrase to find places where that word or phrase is used in the text. It's the perfect shortcut for scanning an articles and locating relevant sections.
