
Construction Update

PRINTING HACKS TO SAVE TREES



Help save paper and save the trees by following these printing habits.

- Review your document before printing.
 Before you click print, check your document for typos,
 missing information, or mistakes to avoid printing it twice.
- Print double-sided when possible.
 Click on More Settings and check the Print on both sides option to use both sides of a sheet of paper and reduce your paper consumption in half.
- Use the page selection option.
 Print only the pages you need by using the costum page selection option in the printing settings.
- Check the last page.
 Make sure you don't have a blank page at the end of your document. If you can't delete it, use the page selection settings to exclude it from your printing job.
- Print individual pages.
 If you need to fix any mistakes, don't print the whole document again. Instead, use the costum page selection option to print individual pages.
- Reuse and recycle paper.
 Reuse paper that has only been printed on one side. When you are done with it, place it in one of the many recycling bins across the school.
