CHROMEBOOK SHORTCUT POWER BUTTON + RELOAD KEY



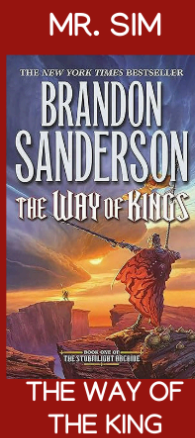
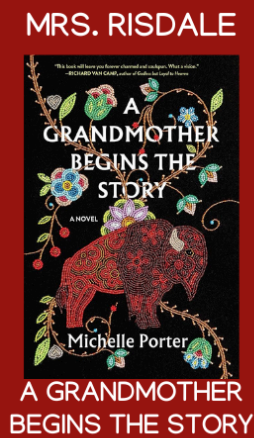
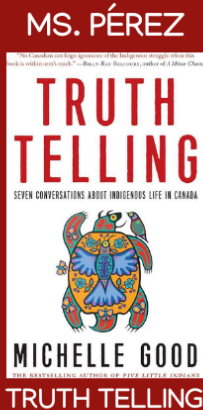
If your Chromebook is not responding, press the start button and the reload key (the circular arrow above the #4 key) and hold for five to ten seconds to restart the Chromebook.

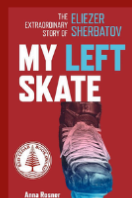
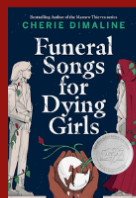


