#### OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS - NEW PROCESS THIS YEAR.

If you are planning on applying to post-secondary school, you will be required to obtain your official transcript directly from the Ministry of Education through My Creds.

Grade 12 students are encouraged to complete the following so when you are ready to apply, you are ready to access / share your transcript with the appropriate institutions.

1 - Go to the following link and select #3 - How to Request your Transcript - then select the yellow button.

2 - Complete the three-part online form.

#### A couple of points to follow:

- Be sure you are using your Legal First Name and Last Name
- For Last School Attended Swift Current Comprehensive High School (unless you will be graduating at a different school).
- Last year attended will be 2025 (since we are in the 2024-2025 school year).
- Learning ID this can be found on your Aspen / MSS Account it would be the 2nd number listed (Learning ID)
- For email be sure to use a personal email (should be student's email, not a
  parent's email AND should NOT be your Chinook email as it needs to be an email
  you can get access to in future years).

In the 3rd part of the form, you will need to take a picture of your ID as well as selfie with the ID and your face. These photos will be uploaded in part 3 of this online form. (Due to this step, it is possible to complete this whole form on your phone while at home).

Once this form is submitted, watch for an email from MyCreds. Students will then be invited to register their MyCreeds account from the link provided. Once your My Creds account has been registered and activated, you will be ready to purchase share credits. Every share cost \$15.00 (plus taxes).

Once you complete your application for a post-secondary school, you may be required to share a transcript with that organization / school.




