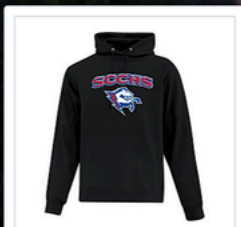

Subject: **Introduction to Bus Status for City buses.**

We're excited to introduce a new way to communicate important updates about your child's school bus. We will be transitioning away from the automated phone calls, texts and emails through SchoolMessenger, but for a time period we will be using both methods. **Please follow the directions below to add the Bus Status app to your device.**

Welcome to Bus Status!

Bus Status is a convenient app that will enable you to quickly get notified if there is a change in the status of your school bus. Example, you'll receive a push notification on your devices if your bus is cancelled or delayed by adding the bus to My Buses. Please follow the steps below. This only applies to City buses at this time.

Please ensure you have push notifications enabled on your device! Follow the steps below.

1. Search "Bus Status" on the App Store or Google Play. Download the **Bus Status 4** app by Box Clever.
2. Open the Bus Status app and select "Chinook School Division".
3. Go to "All Buses". Tap the star to add a bus or buses to My Buses.
4. You'll receive a notification when one of your buses is Delayed or Cancelled but you must allow notifications in settings. Ensure push notifications are enabled in your device settings so you'll be alerted any time one of your selected buses is delayed or cancelled. You can also go into the app to check the status of your bus at any time.
5. Tap the bell icon to see general Notifications.

You can also view **Bus Status** updates on your school website and the Chinook website! *Currently piloting Bus Status for school bus routes in Swift Current only. Click on the Green bus icon in the top banner of the home page, then select the bus or buses your child is registered for.

In order to help keep students safe and on-task, Chinook School Division has implemented the online web filtering services of GoGuardian Admin and is piloting the classroom management services of GoGuardian Teacher at the Swift Current Comprehensive High School. How are we using GoGuardian?

We have chosen GoGuardian Admin services to:

- Help protect students against harmful and inappropriate online material
- Help students stay focused when learning online

We are piloting GoGuardian Teacher services to determine if it meets the following needs:

- Assessing students' progress toward class assignment completion
- Facilitating communication between teachers and students during class time

When and how does GoGuardian operate?

Any time students are logged in to a Chrome browser or a Chromebook with their school account, GoGuardian Admin services are operating.

When in use, GoGuardian Teacher settings operate during school hours on days when school is in session.

What are my parental/guardian and child's responsibilities?

We ask that students use their school-managed Google accounts and school-managed devices for educational purposes within the boundaries of Chinook [AP 140 Technology Acceptable Use](#).

When students are at home, parents play an important role in guiding their internet use. To help support safe and appropriate browsing, your child's school Google account will continue to follow the school's web filtering policies, even when used off campus.

We encourage you to discuss home rules for appropriate internet usage with your child, and reinforce lessons of digital citizenship and safety with him or her. If using a shared family device at home, we recommend that your student log off his or her school Google account when finished.
